Artist Statement

These paintings and prayers emerged from devotional practices that my husband, David (an Anglican priest and professor of theology), and I developed during the time we now call "Covid-tide." David began writing collect prayers (short prayers following a ancient form) and I began making tiny landscape paintings.

In these paintings, you'll find certain repeated elements, one of which is that of a house. Houses nestled in the hills, for me, speak to the way Christ waits for us inside our prayers, companioning us in the wilderness, offering comfort and rest along the way. The elements of gold and graphite exhibit a link between the see and the unseen realities of our world. Graphite lines bridge sky and land, while metallic gold sometimes drips, sometimes floats, through or presses from behind.

David wrote prayers every day for a year, making use of the "collect" form with its typical five-fold shape (from "O Lord" to "In the name of"), which provides a compact way to offer up to God all of the concerns of our hearts.

Though neither of us envisioned this work traveling beyond our own personal lives, when the fog of Covid lifted, it became evident that our combined work might serve others, too. In the summer of 2024, IVP published it as a book, titled "Prayers for the Pilgrimage", which contains over 400 prayers and 22 images.

As I made new paintings for the book, I began to worry that they should be something bigger and more interesting, but I came to see that what I'd already been making was exactly what the book needed, nothing more. Jesus offers us the same in our practice of prayer: we can come to him just as we are with our small hearts and our insufficient words, and they are enough, because he is enough.

Each painting in the gallery is paired with a prayer that we chose from the book. The prayer is made using a process called encaustic, a way of painting with hot beeswax, resin, and pigment. The colors and textures of the wax reference aged gravestones, which are often engraved with scriptures or hymns. These words have stood the test of time and trace the lineage of many faithful saints through time.

As we join the generations of those who have proclaimed the same truth and petitioned the same sorts of prayers to God, may we experience the comfort and companionship of Christ, the guidance of the Holy Spirit through the landscape of prayer, and the welcome of the Father to places of home and rest along the way.


An Evening Prayer

Since then she has been exploring the disciplines of encaustic painting and watercolor. She is interested in ideas of play, journey, memory, and belonging. Her work has been exhibited in juried, group, and solo exhibitions, and is held in private collections of various individuals around the globe. Phaedra lives in Austin, Texas with her husband, Anglican priest and theologian, David Taylor, and two children, Blythe and Sebastian. Together they make creative liturgical resources for families and church communities.

Her days are taken up with attempting to maintain a consistent studio practice while negotiating the demands of motherhood and the joys of gardening.
