Director's Report (Tim Kightlinger - Director of Youth Ministry)

- Recharge starting soon. Last year averaged 75-80. One teen from last year chose to be baptized at Passion Camp.
- Small group ministry going well, 20 volunteers last year, down to 14 this year. Trying to find more volunteers for small group leadership.
- Meal worship time small groups (6/7th curriculum called "Activate," 8/9th study called "Threads," 10-12th curriculum called "The Life"). New video curriculum called 'Dark Room' with tough topics, going along with "The Life" study.
- This year the Recharge theme is 'Unashamed' (to be a Christian).
- Recharge events:
 - Winter retreat with other local churches
 - Extreme event, overnight
 - Looking at an event to celebrate families, looking at October timing.
 - Confirmation begins in 8th grade, confirmed in 9th grade, called Discipleship Foundations.
 - Communion training can start in 6th grade.
 - Summer trip rotates on 3yr schedule:
 - Mission trip (2026)
 - Passion camp replaced National Youth Gathering.
 - Wandering trip

 - Kauai retreat 22 young adults last trip (2024), next trip is scheduled 2026
