



Mission of the Month: Choices Clinic & Life Resources Center



<u>Mission Statement:</u> Choices Life Resource Center is a Christian ministry dedicated to preserving the value of human life by providing abortion alternatives, practical assistance and education to the Cross Timbers area.

As Faith prepares to celebrate Sanctity of Life Sunday, we are, once again, partnering with Choices Clinic & Life Resource Center in January to provide prayer support and financial assistance. The 'Change for Life' baby bottle campaign will begin on January 21 and continue through February. You can begin saving your change now and, on the 21st, pick up and fill your baby bottle. Your support is very important to help Choices provide services in our community such as pregnancy tests, limited ultrasound, material assistance and pregnancy support classes. Choices also offers group support study and individual support sessions to men and women suffering from abortion trauma, women impacted by abuse and to those seeking a growing relationship with Christ.

Lutherans For Life's 2024 theme for Sanctity of Human Life Sunday is

"Just as I AM"

God's blessings to everyone as we begin this new year. As always, LWML continues to fucus on missions for the coming year.

Thanks to all who donated to our mite box in December. We were able to send \$146.43 to support mission projects in Texas and around the world. Our focus this January is *Water and the Word*, an outreach of the Lutheran Church in Kenya, which supports rural schools, children, their parents, and the community at large by sharing God's Word and love through the gift of clean water.

Our Advent by Candlelight event this year was attended by 104 men, women and children who were blessed by the presentation of *Mary's Treasure Box*. Thanks to all our musicians, singers, actresses, table hostesses, and servers who worked to make this happen.

Our Bible study on Joseph, *Meant for Good*, continues January 6th and 20th at 10:00am in Room 6 of the FFC. We will begin with Lesson 5, however, it's not too late to join. If you would like a book, see Marlene Peiser.

On January 14th, we will start the year with Mission Sunday and a presentation on life in a rural village in Kenya. This will be a slide show presentation of Wendy Thornell's (Marlene Peiser's daughter) trip to Kenya in June last year. Wendy will not be able to attend as she works at a homeless shelter in the metroplex, but I will give the presentation using her pictures. A soup and salad lunch will be available after church and before the presentation.

Then, on January 21st, we will sponsor Muffins for Missions by providing muffins and other goodies before Sunday School and church. The large mite box will be out, so please donate if you can.

Finally, we have an update on the fundraiser we had last year to raise money to purchase a TV for use in the Narthex and Sanctuary. Burl Peiser is putting the finishing touches on the cabinet to house the new TV. However, LWML has used all of its \$662 in purchasing lumber for the cabinet so we will need additional fundraisers to finish the project. I'm sure the Church Council would welcome any ideas.

May we continue to thank God for all His blessings granted to us this past year and in the coming year.
