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# **COURSE DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE**

# **LESSONS**

**Lesson 1** – To introduce, explain the purpose, and detail the plan of the course. Also to provide fundamental sound doctrine upon which the course lessons will build upon.

**Lesson 3** – To study leadership qualities of <u>integrity</u> by examining "blameless", "good behaviour", and "good report".

**Lesson 4** – To study leadership qualities of <u>integrity</u> by examining "holy", "just", and "ensample".

**Lesson 5** – To study leadership qualities concerning the Word of God by examining "the faithful word" and "apt to teach".

**Lesson 6** – To study leadership qualities concerning the Word of God by examining "exhort" and "convince gainsayers."

**Lesson 7** – To study leadership qualities regarding <u>family</u> by examining "husband of one wife" and "children in subjection."

**Lesson 8** – To study leadership qualities that are <u>personal</u> by examining "take care of house" and "lover of good men".

**Lesson 9** – To study leadership qualities that are <u>personal</u> by examining "vigilant", "sober", and being "temperate".

**Lesson 10** – To study leadership qualities that are <u>personal</u> by examining "not a novice", "not given to wine", and "not greedy".

**Lesson 11** – To study leadership qualities that are <u>relational</u> by examining "given to hospitality", "patient", and "not lords".

**Lesson 12** – To study leadership qualities that are <u>relational</u> by examining "no striker", "not a brawler", "not selfwilled", "and "not soon angry".
