## **Trinity Aviation Academy Statement of Faith**

Trinity Aviation Academy is a Christian training center which stands firmly on the following beliefs.

- We believe the Bible is the inspired, infallible, authoritative Word of God. (2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:21)
- We believe there is one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 28:19; 1 Corinthians 8:6)
- We believe Jesus is fully God and fully man. And, we believe in His virgin birth, His perfect life, His redeeming death, His bodily resurrection, His heavenly ascension, and His personal return. (Colossians 1:15; Philippians 2:5-8; Matthew 1:18-25; 1 Peter 2:24-25; Luke 24; Hebrews 4:14-16; Acts 1:9-11; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-18; Matthew 25:31-46; Revelation 11:15-17; 20:4-6, 11-15)
- We believe the Holy Spirit dwells in all believers, conforming them to the image of Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 12:13, Romans 8:16 17)
- We believe everyone has sinned and is subject to God's wrath and condemnation; and redemption is only through faith in Jesus Christ. Being born again is the only way to be redeemed from the guilt, penalty, and power of sin. (Romans 3:10, 23 John 3:3; John 14:6; Acts 13:38-39; John 3:16)
- We believe the Church is the unity of all believers whose mission is to glorify God and to take the Gospel to all nations. (Acts 2:41; 15:13-17; Ephesians 1:3-6; 1 Corinthians 12:12-13; Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 1:6-8)
- We believe God created people male or female and that marriage is between one man and one woman. (Genesis 1:27, 2:24)

## **Biblical Absolutes**

Trinity students live, work, and study in a close Biblical community, so we draw special attention to the following practices we believe expressively violate Biblical absolutes. All Trinity Aviation Academy staff, volunteers, students, and visitors agree to refrain from:

- The use or possession of pornographic or any morally degrading literature or media (Romans 13:14)
- Sexual immorality (1Thesalonians 4:3)
- Dishonesty (Ephesians 4:15, 25)
- Abusive behavior (Romans 14:9)
- Theft or destruction of property (Ephesians 4:28)
- Any illegal activity (Romans 13:1-2)
- Use of foul language (Ephesians 5:4)
- Drunkenness (Ephesians 5:18; Romans 13:13)
