

Events & Outreach













Easter We celebrated the Risen King with 3 services and 2 egg hunts! Over 1,400 guests joined us over Easter weekend and kids helped collect 7,000 Easter eggs!

Spring & Fall Food Drops Almost 600 meals were donated through thousands of pounds of groceries, fresh produce, hams, turkeys, and more. Between both Food Drops, at least 150 volunteers pulled together to organize, prep, and handout meals. We also provided special hospitality for our guests with window washing, hot beverages, cookies, and prayer while they waited.

Camp Kids Street The best week of summer was a blast for over 120 campers and 45 volunteers. Crossroaders donated supplies and snacks to ensure we had everything we needed for a great week! Campers helped with a service project too – donating 520 boxes of cereal to help stock area food pantries.

Kickoff The Kickoff is one of our favorite days of the year. We geared up in jerseys to kickoff the football season, and gathered together for worship, community, food trucks and more!

Chip N For Children 124 golfers came out to participate in this years outing to support and raise funds for a local teen. Over \$23,000 was raised for Raelynn Malosh, a Blissfield H.S. student battling cancer.











Fall Fests Crossroads impacted 2 community Fall Fests this year in Whiteford and Sylvania! In Whiteford, volunteers hosted a booth and provided lunch to all of the festival vendors. We also hosted a booth at Sylvania Fall fest and continued our honored role of being the Grand Marshal of the parade. Over 110 volunteers impacted the community over the course of these two fun weekends!

Trunk or Treat Reaching out to our community in a fun way with a safe place to trunk or treat, with candy, inflatables, hayrides, music, and food trucks. 3000+ quests joined us and 72 families hosted trunks to pass out candy. Generosity was shown with \$1,000 and 252 bags of candy donated - plus 100+ volunteers helped make this fun night possible.

Angel Tree 120 gifts were purchased by the Crossroads community and gifted to the Monroe County ISD for families in need. Also, a family in Sylvania who lost their home was adopted for Christmas. 14 Volunteers helped organize and deliver gifts!

Christmas Eve Our focus was set on "Emmanuel – God with us!" Over 1,400 guests joined us in person and online over the 3 holiday services.

God Works Each Thursday, the God Works team serves a home cooked meal at Crossroads. Almost 1.900 meals were served in 2023 and 386 people volunteered throughout the year to plan. cook, and serve meals to our amazing guests.

From December 2022 through January 2023, Crossroads aimed to raise \$190,000 for the annual HOC offering. As it turned out, together we donated \$218,730!

Here's how that money was put to use:

MISSION - WHITEFORD PLAYGROUND (LOCAL): \$19.000

Given to help our neighbors in Whiteford work towards their \$500,000 goal needed to build an inclusive playground, right in our backyard at Stone Co. Park.

MISSION - HAITI HOSPITAL (GLOBAL): \$19.000

Given to our longtime friends in Dessalines, Haiti, to support the Claire Heureuse Hospital. This hospital is in a financial crisis and in great need of medicine, diesel for generators, and food for patients.

CROSSROADS: \$180.730

By allocating 80% of the HOC funds to the Crossroads Path to Financial Health, it allows us to take the next step in our path to financial health. These funds will get us close to completing our Emergency Building Fund.


