- Acts 8:32 (NLT) The passage of Scripture he had been reading was this: "He was led like a sheep to the slaughter. And as a lamb is silent before the shearers, he did not open his mouth.
- Acts 8:33 (NLT) He was humiliated and received no justice. Who can speak of his descendants? For his life was taken from the earth."
- Acts 8:34 (NLT) The eunuch asked Philip, "Tell me, was the prophet talking about himself or someone else?"
- Acts 8:35 (NLT) So beginning with this same Scripture, Philip told him the Good News about Jesus.
- Acts 8:36 (NLT) As they rode along, they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "Look! There's some water! Why can't I be baptized?"
