- Jesus didn't die to help us follow Moses better. He died to fulfill the law and start something entirely new.
- Luke 22:14–20 (NLT)
- Luke 22:14- 15 (NLT) When the time came, Jesus and the apostles sat down together at the table. Jesus said, “I have been very eager to eat this **Passover meal** with you before my **suffering begins.**”
- Luke 22:16-18 (NLT) For I tell you now that I won't eat this meal again until its meaning is **fulfilled** in the Kingdom of God.” Then he took a cup of wine and gave thanks to God for it. Then he said, “Take this and share it among yourselves. For I will not drink wine again until the Kingdom of God has come.”
- Luke 22:19 (NLT) He took some bread and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and gave it to the disciples, saying, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in **remembrance of me.**”
- Luke 22:20 (NLT) After supper he took another cup of wine and said, “This cup is the **new covenant** between God and his people—an **agreement confirmed** with **my blood**, which is poured out as a **sacrifice for you.**”

- Hebrews 8:6-13 (NLT)
- Hebrews 8:6 (NLT) But now Jesus, our **High Priest**, has been given a ministry that is far superior to the old priesthood, for he is the one who mediates for us a far **better covenant** with God, based on **better promises**.
- Hebrews 8:10 (NLT) But this is the new covenant I will make with the people of Israel on that day, says the Lord: I will put **my laws** in their **minds**, and I will **write** them on their **hearts**. I will be their God, and they will be my people.
- **Internal** transformation, not **external** rules.
- Hebrews 8:12 (NLT) And I will **forgive** their **wickedness**, and I will **never again** remember their **sins**.”
- Full forgiveness—not **earned**, but **gifted**.
- Hebrews 8:13 (NLT) When God speaks of a “new” covenant, it means he has made the first one obsolete. It is now out of date and will soon disappear.
- **Old Covenant:** Nation, land, law, war
- **New Covenant:** Grace, inner change, love, forgiveness
