## **QUESTIONS:**

- 1. In what ways did your parents prepare you for life? Was there anything that you weren't prepared for?
  - If you're a parent, how do these experiences affect the way you are raising your child(ren)?
- 2. How can you influence a child's development in the following areas: intellectual, physical, character, relationships?
- 3. What are some decisions that you made in the past that are still affecting you today? (both positive and negative)
  - How can I use these decisions to help others?
- 4. What are some difficulties/storms around you where you can display peace?
- 5. How can we be intentional about investing in and developing the children around us?
- 6. Do your children and/or family know your testimony? Can you use your testimony over the holidays to help bring a family member closer to Jesus?
- 7. What does it look like for your house to serve the Lord?
  - How are you fostering growth in your home?

## PRAYER:

Please don't stress about the time of prayer, pray however your group feels comfortable. This can either be one person pray, or you can go in a circle and have each person pray a few sentences! Be sure to change it up so your prayer time stays fresh in your group.

- Have someone type your requests up so the group can recall them throughout the week.
