- a. Upon completion students should gain more of an understanding of:
 - i. **Generosity University**

 - ii. **Disciplines of a Christian Life**

 - 2. Students should gain more of an understanding that our spiritual disciplines are not the fruit of a Christian life and earn us nothing with God. However, they do unlock the flow of God to us and through us which results in genuine transformation rather than surface modification.
 - 3. Students should gain more of an understanding that their spiritual walk requires the posturing of themselves inwardly, outwardly and corporately while we discuss simple ways of how to do that.
