### December 2023 – John 14:27 (Peace):

**Short:** “Peace I leave with you, Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.”

**Long:** “Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.”

### January 2024 – Number 14:18 (Longsuffering):

**Short:** “The Lord is longsuffering and abundant in mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression.”

**Long:** “The Lord is longsuffering and abundant in mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression; but He by no means clears *the guilty*.”

### February 2024 – Romans 2:4 (Kindness/Goodness):

**Short:** “The goodness of God leads you to repentance?”

**Long:** “Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?”

### March 2024 – Psalm 37:3 (Faithfulness/Gentleness):

**Short:** “Trust in the Lord, and do good; and feed on His faithfulness.”

**Long:** “Trust in the Lord, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.”

### April 2024 – Titus 1:7-8 (Self-Control):

**Short:** “For a bishop must be blameless, a lover of what is good, sober-minded, just, holy, self-controlled,”

**Long:** “For a bishop must be blameless, as a steward of God, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, not violent, not greedy for money, but hospitable, a lover of what is good, sober-minded, just, holy, self-controlled,”
