The idea that we can do nothing toward our transformation is an unfortunate confusion of our time, and those who sponsor it never practice it, thank goodness.


If we – through well-directed and unrelenting action (*being gifted by the Holy Spirit to do so*) – effectually receive the grace of God in salvation and transformation, we certainly will be incrementally changed toward inward Christlikeness. And the transformation of our outer life, especially our behavior, will follow suit. That, too, is an inescapable fact: “No good tree produces bad fruit.” (Luke 6:43, PAR).

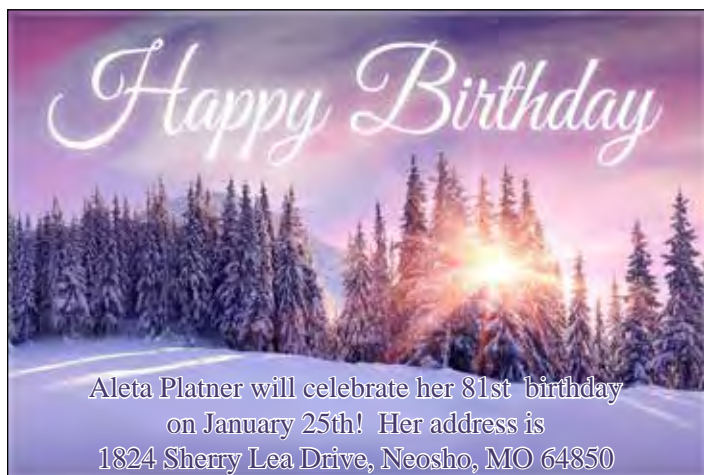
