

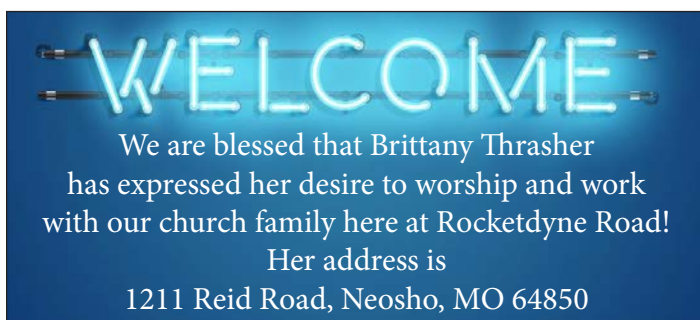

We will have a great time of worship, fellowship and refreshments following the service.

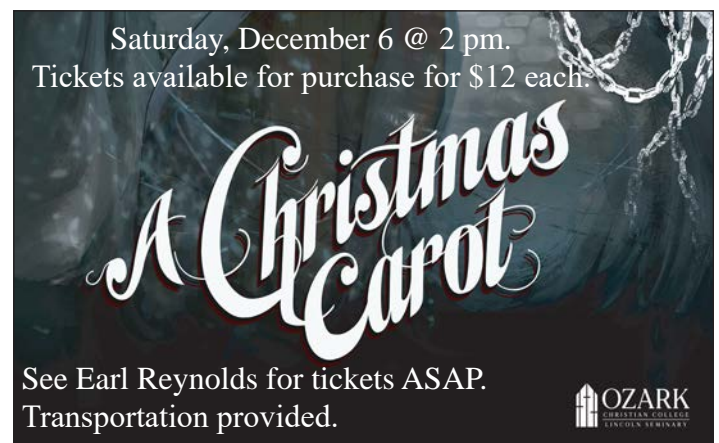
JESUS LOVES FAMILY
