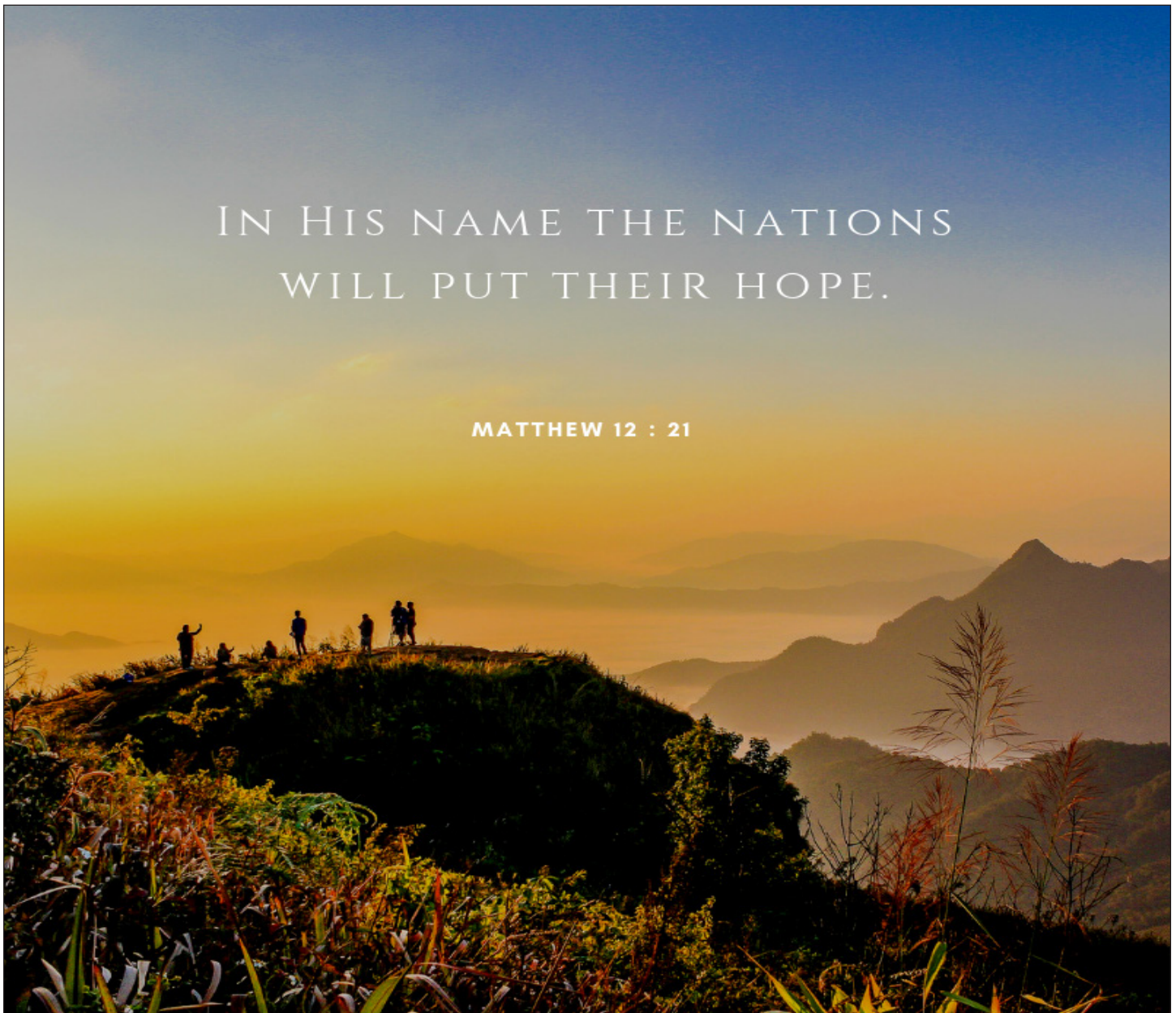

My Only Hope is You, Jesus

At a time when His followers thought all hope was lost, Jesus reminded them that He is their hope.

For 3 years, Jesus' disciples followed Him in Hope. Following Him, they witnessed lepers cleansed, the blind had their sight restored, the deaf could hear, the mute could talk, and demons were cast out and could no longer torment their subjects with a lack of hope. They heard of sins being forgiven and witnessed lives drastically changed to be aligned with the Kingdom of God. And, they heard His messages of Hope for the present and the future.

In the end, Jesus told them that He was leaving, to be with the Father. The journey of hope felt as if it was coming to an end for them, because He was their only hope. So, Jesus reassured them when He said, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." And, "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you." And, "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you." And finally, "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace (hope). In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."

Jesus spoke hope into their lives at a time of great turmoil.
