

The story of Jesus (Second half)

Let's go to page 1597 in your Bible and read **Luke 18:31-34**

where Jesus predicts His death:

'Jesus took the Twelve aside and told them, "We are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written by the prophets about the Son of Man will be fulfilled. He will be delivered over to the Gentiles. They will mock him, insult him and spit on him; they will flog him and kill him. On the third day he will rise again." The disciples did not understand any of this. Its meaning was hidden from them, and they did not know what he was talking about.'

Luke 22:7-38**Passover meal, Last Supper**

Remember what happened in Exodus 12:12-13?

The evening before Jesus was killed, He celebrated the Passover meal with His disciples, in remembrance how God had saved His people from slavery in Egypt. Read Luke 22:7-38. Difficult words?

1. What did Jesus say and promise during the dinner (verses 16, 18, 20, 29-30)?
2. Read verses 31-34 again. What did Jesus say about Peter's future job (verses 32)?
3. What was Peter's promise (verse 33)?
4. Did Peter do that (verses 54-62)?

Luke 22:63-23:24**Jesus mocked and led before Pilate and Herod, trial**

1. What miracle happened during Jesus' arrest (verses 22:49-51)?
2. The religious leaders accused Jesus for blasphemy and claiming to be a king. What did Pilate ask Jesus at the trial and what was Jesus answer (verse 23:3)? Why did Jesus give this type of answer?
3. What motivated Pontius Pilate to crucify Jesus (verses 20-25)?

Luke 23:26-49**The crucifixion of Jesus**

1. What's the reason why Jesus had to die (Romans 3:19-26)?
2. While Jesus hung on the cross He spoke with the Father and he said something about those who killed him (verse 34)?

3. What were the last words Jesus said before He died (v. 46)? How does John describe this in John 19:30?

Luke 24:1-12**Jesus has risen**

The women went to the tomb and expected Jesus' body still there.

Two angels said two things to them (see verses 5-7):

1. Looking for living among the dead? What does this mean?
2. Remember Jesus' own words. Which words? Explain.

3. Who are the Eleven in verse 9?
4. Were the apostles prepared for the resurrection according to verse 11?
