Moms and grandmoms, your decisions can affect generations.

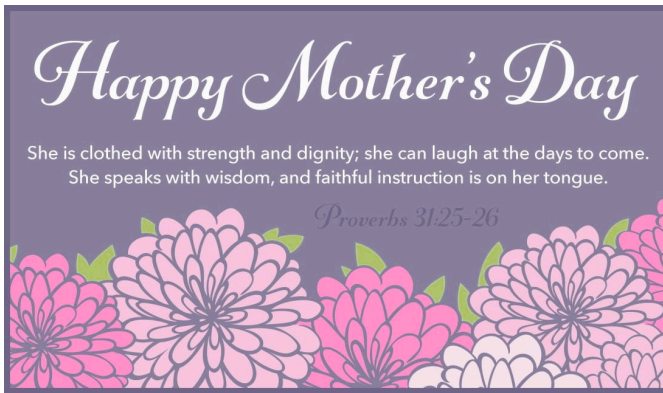
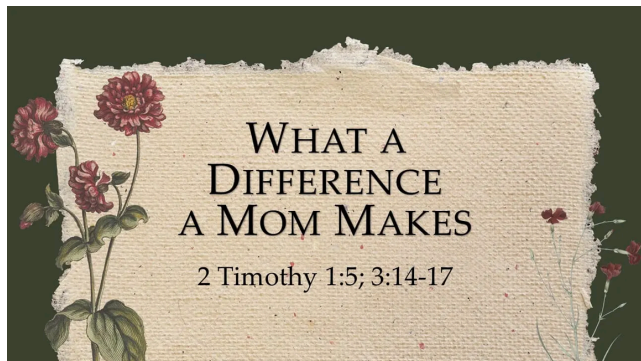
How beautiful that Timothy's mom and grandmom helped nurture his faith so he could become the man God was calling him to be.
