# Pastor K. Edward Copeland Bio



### Lead Pastor

Pastor Copeland is a minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ who has been blessed with many talents and skills. He is a musician, composer, preacher, lecturer, author and attorney. He is most widely known for his Godgiven gift to teach the Bible with supernatural clarity and simplicity. He is the author of Riding in the Second Chariot, a guide for ministers and church leaders and a contributing author to Entrusted with the Gospel by Crossway. He is a graduate of the University of Illinois (B.A. 1984), University of California-Berkeley (J.D. 1987), Golden Gate Theological Seminary (M.Div. 1992), and Trinity Evangelical Divinity School (D.Min. 2017). His lives with his bride of 32 years, Starla, and they have three children Jibri, Abeni, and Titus.

#### **EBC CHURCH ANNIVERSARY**

During the time of migration from the south of African American workers and a World War, a small group of African American Beloit residents felt the need to meet at Kent Hall on State Street to formally establish what was then named the Second Emmanuel Baptist

Church. The following persons were present on April 15, 1917, for this purpose:

Emmanuel was officially recognized and chartered by the Rock County Registrar on July 12, 1917. The formal incorporation papers were filed on June 3, 1927, in the same office. Later, the church moved to the upstairs of a hall on Third and West Grand. In 1919, the church moved to Booth Hall on East Grand Ave. A building on St. Paul Ave. was purchased to serve as the church edifice and then sold in 1925 for \$3,500. The present church lot was purchased prior to this on April 30, 1924. A concrete structure was completed in 1927 at a cost of \$5,500. This edifice was destroyed by a fire in early 1958. The present church edifice was completed in 1960. In the late 1960's, the former parsonage on East Grand Ave was replaced by the one on Afton Road. The present Educational enter was also purchased during this time. An addition to the church, which includes the Family Life Center and new administrative offices were completed in 2007.
