About this Booklet

This booklet is designed to help you understand the process of spiritual growth —and how Thrive's programming can support you on that journey.

The material in this booklet embraces the natural rhythm of life—our **daily practices** as apprentices of Jesus, the weekly Sabbath, the annual rhythm of church life, and a three-year Apprenticeship to Jesus. You will also see the stages of spiritual development that mark our lifelong journey toward spiritual maturity.

How NOT to use this booklet: This is not a checklist of tasks to complete. Instead, it's a guide to help you consider what lifelong apprenticeship to Jesus can look like. Thrive's programming simply provides direction and insight into how the Lord transforms our character over time.

The Three-Year Apprenticeship at Thrive

In modern Western culture, discipleship is often shaped by a Greek-style model of education: information-based, curriculum-driven, and focused on knowledge retention. While this approach has value for learning doctrine, it does little to transform character. True spiritual growth is about character transformation. We go from who we were to who Jesus is

In Jesus' day, a rabbi called people to apprentice under him. Apprenticeship was "learning along the way," much like how electricians or plumbers learn through hands-on experience. It's about process, not pass/fail.

Our Three-Year Apprenticeship at Thrive offers a series of intentional spiritual experiences designed to help you grow "along the way," learning with and from more seasoned followers of Jesus.

Thrive Three Year Apprenticeship Journey

Most people begin in the crowd:

As part of the crowd, you might attend Sunday services regularly or intermittently and join in holiday events like Easter and Christmas. However, you're not actively engaging in the seven spiritual growth ingredients or participating in key events like the Growth Track, Prayer & Fasting Weeks, Spiritual Retreats, Serve Day, or the Bible-in-a-Year discussion group.

In your first apprenticeship year, we recommend that you:

Complete the four-week Growth Track and engage in key discipleship events: Sunday services, Prayer & Fasting Weeks, Men's Camp or Women's retreat, Serve Day, and Holiday events (Passover Seder, Easter, Christmas). Most importantly, join the Bible-in-a-Year discussion group.

Year 2:

In your second year of apprenticeship, participate in the same Thrive Apprenticeship calendar events as in year one. **But now**, lead a table at the Bible-in-a-Year discussion group, provided you attended for most of the previous year. Complete Semesters 1 and 2 of the **Thrive Leadership Academy** (TLA).

Year 3:

Continue participating in the Thrive Apprenticeship calendar of events. Complete Semesters 3 and 4 of the Thrive Leadership Academy (TLA). Attend the Thrive **Small Group Academy** and take on the role of leading a small group.

Daily Apprenticeship

According to research at the Center for Bible Engagement (Scientific Evidence for the Power of 4; 2012) research shows that people who engage with Scripture at least four times per week experience measurable life change. That's why our Bible-in-a-Year plan is built for daily, lifelong Scripture engagement.

In Jesus' day, Scripture reading was always communal—personal Bibles didn't exist. Transformation happens not only through reading but through wrestling with Scripture together. Our Bible-in-a-Year discussion groups are designed to help you do just that—read, reflect, question, and grow together as apprentices of Jesus.

Bible in a Year Discussion Groups

Weekly discussion groups accompany the daily readings, creating a space for meaningful conversations and deeper engagement. These groups help bring the Bible to life. We'd love for you to join us! What Makes Thrive's Bible Reading Plan Unique?

Focus on Intentionality, Not Just a Checklist:

Unlike traditional one-year Bible plans that prioritize finishing the Bible in a year, our plan emphasizes intentional readings while still covering the entire Bible in one year.

Each day, the Proverbs are the first reading portion. This is because, in the beginning, many people struggle with the volume of reading. Therefore, consider reading just the Proverbs as you begin to develop the habit of opening up the scriptures daily. Once Bible reading has become a daily spiritual discipline, then you can expand the volume of the reading.

Balanced Old and New Testament Readings:

Chronological plans often spend most of the year in the Old Testament, delaying New Testament readings until late in the year. Our plan ensures a balance by including New Testament readings throughout, while still following a chronological order.

Gospel Readings Spread Throughout the Year:

Traditional plans place the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John) back-to-back, which can feel repetitive. Our plan spreads the Gospels across the year, allowing readers to revisit Jesus' life and teachings consistently.

Weekly Discipleship Observances

The weekly Sabbath was a cornerstone of Jewish discipleship—and it remains vital today. In fact, the command to remember the Sabbath is not only one of the Ten Commandments but also the one given the most attention. It's as if God is saying, "If you keep this commandment, you'll be able to keep the others."

We can't love God or people well when we're hurried, burned out, or overextended. The Sabbath is God's built-in rhythm for rest and renewal after six days of doing too much in too little time.

Our Sabbath Devotional is designed to help you grow in your understanding of what makes this day holy and why God blesses this day uniquely.

Suggestions on How You Might Observe the Sabbath

First, remember—there is no legalism in observing the Sabbath. This day is a gift from the Lord to refresh and renew us. We get to choose how we receive and use that gift. We can ignore it (to our detriment), or embrace it with joy—which nourishes our souls and accelerates our spiritual growth. That's exactly what Jesus desires for us.

Start by choosing a day that fits your life rhythm to "remember the Sabbath." This will be a 24-hour period set aside to appreciate the life Jesus has given you. Think of it like a mini Thanksgiving—a day of gratitude, feasting, and celebration!

Life happens, and sometimes your Sabbath day may need to shift. That's okay. There's no legalism in the gift of Sabbath. For most people who work during the week, Saturday evening to Sunday evening works best. Here's what that might look like for you:

Preparing for the Sabbath

Use Saturday as your day of preparation—finish yard work, household chores, and any tasks that might distract you. Plan or prep your special Sabbath meal in advance.

Once preparation is complete, enter into your Sabbath rest from Saturday evening through Sunday evening. To truly receive God's gift of rest, set boundaries to protect the peace He wants to give you.

- To let your soul rest: avoid anything related to your profession or work.
- To let your attitude rest: stay away from media or social media that might steal your joy. If the news stirs frustration or anger, turn it off for 24 hours.
- To let your emotions rest: skip tense or corrective conversations with family. There are six other days for tough talks—this day is for delighting in those God has placed in your life.
- To let your body rest: hold off on big DIY projects or strenuous tasks that drain your energy.

How the Keirstead Family Remembers the Sabbath

Our family rhythm may give you a starting point for your own. Don't feel pressured to copy it—use it as inspiration to find what fits your family best.

We begin by gathering around the dinner table. One of the ladies of the house lights the two Sabbath candles while the other recites the candle-lighting prayer. The two candles traditionally represent the words "remember" and "observe" from Exodus 20:8 and Deuteronomy 5:12.

In Jewish tradition, the Sabbath (Shabbat) is often personified as a queen or bride, symbolizing beauty, holiness, and relationship. Lighting the candles honors that sacred presence—welcoming the Sabbath with grace and joy.

Candle-Lighting Prayer:

"Blessed are You, O Lord our God, King of the universe, who created the Sabbath as Your gift to us—to strengthen our spirit through worship, renew our souls through gratitude, and restore our bodies through rest."

After lighting the candles, one person reads a Bible verse and another shares the Sabbath devotional connected to it. Then, each person prays for both our natural and spiritual family's needs.

When we finish praying, we light an LED candle that stays on until the 24-hour Sabbath ends. As we blow out the real candles, we say, "There go our worries and our stress." Then we joyfully proclaim in our best Hebrew, "Shabbat Shalom!"—which means "peaceful Sabbath."

Saturday night we either go out together or order in dinner to celebrate.

Sunday on the Sabbath

Sunday is for worship, prayer, generosity, and service. We not only tell the Lord we're grateful—we show Him through our participation in the life of the Church.

After church, we enjoy our special Sabbath meal. In our house, that means homemade pizzas! Then we rest, relax, swim, enjoy dessert, laugh, and sometimes walk on the beach. These quiet family moments become lifelong memories.

Concluding the Sabbath

As the sun sets on Sunday, we say "goodbye for now" to the Sabbath. We relight the candles, turn off the LED light, and pray a final blessing of gratitude:

Sabbath Conclusion Prayer:

"Blessed are You, O Lord our God, King of the universe, who separates the holy from the ordinary, light from darkness, Your people from the nations. Blessed are You, O Lord, who distinguishes the holy seventh day from the six days of labor."

We blow out the candles and say, "Goodbye, Sabbath," already looking forward to the next time we can joyfully shout, "Shabbat Shalom!"

Week 1

Genesis 2:2–3 – On the seventh day God had finished His work of creation, so He rested from all his work. And God blessed the seventh day and declared it holy, because it was the day when He rested from all His work of creation.

"The Hebrew word Shabbat means "to stop," but it can also be translated "to delight," It has the dual idea of stopping and also of enjoying God and our lives in this world. The Sabbath is an entire day set aside to follow God's example to stop and to delight: To delight in the world... to delight in our lives in it and above all, to delight in God himself" (Ruthless Elimination of Hurry, by John Mark Comer, p. 155).

Week 2

Matthew 5:17 – "Don't misunderstand why I have come. I did not come to abolish the law of Moses or the writings of the prophets. No, I came to accomplish their purpose."

"The Sabbath is not merely a good idea; it is one of the 10 Commandments. Jesus did not cancel or annul the idea of the Sabbath. In the 10 Commandments, the 4th (Sabbath) is the bridge that takes us from the first three which focus on God, to the final five, which concentrate on our relationships with other others" (Sabbath, by Dan Allender, p. 5).

Week 3

Matthew 11:28–30 – "Come to Me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest... For My yoke is easy and my burden is light."

"The Sabbath is not a time for personal anxieties or care or any activity that might dampen in the spirit of joy. The Sabbath is not a time to remember sins, to confess or to repent. It is a day of praise, not a day of petitions. Fasting and mourning and demonstrations of grief are forbidden. It is a sin to be sad on the Sabbath. For the Sabbath is a day of harmony and peace between man and man, peace within man, and peace with all things" (Sabbath, by Abraham Joshua Herschel, p. 30-31).

Week 4

Psalm 19:1 – The heavens proclaim the glory of God. The skies display His craftsmanship. Day after day they continue to speak; night after night they make Him known. They speak without a sound or word; their voice is never heard. Yet their message has gone throughout the earth, and their words to all the world.

"The true meaning of Sabbath is ecological. Only someone who comes to rest and has nothing planned is able to perceive the beauty of creation around him. He or she sees the flowers and the sunset or a beloved person. We are called to adore and honor the Earth as God's Art, especially on the day He set aside to Marvel at His own creation" (Sabbath, by Dan Allender, p. 67-68).

Thrive Annual Apprenticeship Calendar (with Spiritual Growth Ingredients)

The backbone of our three-year apprenticeship plan is the rhythm of our Annual Apprenticeship Calendar. In Jesus' day, God's people observed annual festivals and pilgrimages that taught them about their story, their community, and their God. These experiences were not merely educational—they required sacrifice of time, energy, and resources. That's becasue education changes the mind, but sacrifice transforms the character.

Likewise, through our annual rhythm of engaging with all seven Spiritual Growth Ingredients, you will be provided with an opportunity for education and encountering age-old spiritual disciplines that can feel like a sacrifice. Our hope is that you'll join your church family "along the way" in shared experiences that shape our hearts to live as Jesus lived.

The seven Spiritual Growth Ingredients come to us from the description of the early church in the book of Acts.

Acts 2:42-47 (NLT) – All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching (personal study), and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals and to prayer (prayer and fasting). A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders (service). And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need (generosity). They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity ... And each day the Lord added to their fellowship (evangelism) those who were being saved.

The Seven Spiritual Growth Ingredients Defined

Personal Study A continual approach to spiritual transformation that includes Scripture reading, study, memorization and application. This is the role of the Bible in a Year reading plan and discussion groups.

Christian Fellowship Life-giving relationships with other believers marked by authenticity and accountability. This is the role of small groups.

Prayer and Fasting Intentional, dedicated seasons of prayer and meditation, along with skipping meals and stepping away from anything that influences us—such as media or social media.

Service Intentionally and consistently serving God by serving His body, the church. This is the role of the Thrive Dream Team

Generosity An attitude of open-handedness, especially in finances, but also includes our time and talents.

Evangelism Inviting people into a relationship with Jesus by sharing your personal story, inviting others to church, and serving the lost in Jesus' name.

Worship Together A gathering with other believers to collaboratively connect with God.

The Lifelong Discipleship Journey

All life grows through stages. The mighty oak begins as an acorn, becomes a seedling, and eventually matures into a strong, reproducing tree. Likewise, we move from infancy to childhood, adolescence, and finally to mature adulthood. Each stage has distinct characteristics that define it.

The same is true in our spiritual lives. In the New Testament, the Apostle Paul urged believers to grow from "babes in Christ" to mature disciples. The question is: Where am I in my discipleship journey? I might have attended church for 20 years, but has there been 20 years of transformation—from who I was to who Jesus is? More specifically, when I face adversity or pressure, how closely does my life reflect the Beatitudes (Matthew 5:3–12) and the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22–23)?




