ICE BREAK

 Talk about a time when your parents/someone in authority let you do something that was not good for you that resulted in a better relationship with them.

STUDY

This week we focus on God molding us to trust Him more by <u>allowing us to suffer</u> the consequences of our disobedience.

What did you hear in this week's sermon that was new about God's <u>Tough Love</u>?

1. Read Jeremiah 18:1-11

- a. What is your initial reaction to God saying "I am preparing a disaster for you..."?
- b. How do you reconcile that with our trust that "God is Love and Loves us"?
- c. How are we, and our future, like <u>clay to be</u> <u>molded</u>?
- d. What part did Israel's behavior play in *molding their own future*?
- e. Explain: <u>God used Babylon to cause Israel to seek Him again</u>.
- f. How does lying affect our soul, relationships? What is the <u>"price of the cover-up"</u>?
- 2. Acts 17:26-27: God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him.
 - a. What if one of God's main purposes is molding us not only *via* tough times but *with* trials?
 - b. How common is it for you, during trials, to pray to "just get them over with"?
 - c. Should we instead pray: God, don't let this trial pass <u>until I have been molded to seek you</u> <u>more</u>?.

- i. How do you understand and react to:
 God goes against us because He´s for us?
- ii. We often say: **God is in control** In what ways is our future- *in our own hands also*?
- iii. Israel had prophets like Daniel to warn them from <u>wandering from God</u>, who is a <u>prophet in your life</u>?

 Reflect: What time in your life led you to a point of <u>seeking the Lord with all of your</u> <u>heart?</u>

- Pray for each other for God's guidance during trials in life.
- Follow up on past prayer requests.
- Pray for the mission God has given each of us to live out daily.
