Small Group Discussion Guide

VOL 2: Part 10: Two Men, Two Destinies: Adam and Christ | PALM SUNDAY

Message Reflection

BIG Idea: You were born into Adam's story—but you're invited into Christ's.

Application: If you're in Christ, you are no longer defined by Adam's failure—but by Jesus' victory. Live like grace reigns.

Discussion Questions

Icebreaker: What's one decision someone else made that has greatly affected your life—for better or worse?

- 1. Read Romans 5:12–14. How does Paul describe the legacy of Adam's sin?
- 2. What does it mean that we were "in Adam" when he sinned? How does that idea challenge Western views of individuality?
- 3. Why is the concept of a representative (Adam or Christ) essential to understanding the gospel?
- 4. How does Christ's obedience reverse Adam's disobedience? (v.18–19)
- 5. What stood out to you about the "contrast" between Adam and Jesus? (v.15–17)
- 6. Paul says grace not only forgives but reigns. What does that look like practically in a believer's life?
- 7. How does this passage reframe your sense of identity in Christ?
- 8. Why is it important that Paul emphasizes "much more" grace than sin? (v.20)
- 9. How can you help others move from living under Adam's curse to walking in Christ's victory?
- 10. What's one way this message calls you to live differently this week?

Prayer Prompt: Thank God for the gift of grace and righteousness in Christ. Pray for each other to live boldly in the freedom and victory Jesus has won. Ask the Spirit to show any areas still operating under guilt, shame, or fear from the old story—and invite Him to bring renewed identity and life in Christ.
