## Small Group Discussion Guide

VOL 4: Part 26: Authentic Love: Living The Gospel

**BIG Idea**: Authentic love is the gospel lived out—sincere, truthful, devoted, patient, generous, and visible in action.

**Application:** Live out authentic love in your relationships by letting the Holy Spirit transform your sincerity, truth, devotion, patience, and generosity, so that Christ is seen through you.

## **Discussion Questions**

**Icebreaker:** What's one example you've seen (in a friend, family member, or even in a stranger) of love that felt truly genuine?

- 1. Read Romans 12:9. What's the difference between pretending to love and actually loving? Why do you think Paul starts here?
- 2. Why does Paul tie together "loving what is good" with "hating what is evil" (Rom. 12:9b)? How does that shape our view of authentic love?
- 3. Jeremiah 17:9 says the heart is deceitful. How do we guard against letting our emotions redefine what's good or evil?
- 4. How does Romans 5:8 (Christ's love for us while we were still sinners) shape the way we love people who are difficult to love?
- 5. What does it practically look like to be "devoted to one another in love" as Paul commands in Romans 12:10?
- 6. Philippians 2:3 tells us to value others above ourselves. Share a time when you saw someone live that out. How can you practice this week?
- 7. Romans 12:11–12 calls for zeal, fervor, hope, patience, and prayer. Which of these do you find easiest to live out? Which is hardest?
- 8. In Romans 12:13, Paul calls us to meet needs and practice hospitality. What does hospitality look like for you, and how can your group live this out more intentionally?
- 9. What would change in our community if our love were consistently authentic?
- 10. Which one aspect of authentic love (sincere, truthful, devoted, honoring, patient, generous, or hospitable) do you most want to grow in right now?

**Prayer Prompt:** Spend time praying for God to remove surface-level love in your hearts, to ignite fresh zeal through the Spirit, and to help your group embody authentic love in practical ways that point people to Christ.
