VOL 4: Part 34: Partnership in the Gospel: Generosity & Prayer

BIG Idea: Gospel partnership thrives through generous giving and earnest prayer.

Application: We are called to participate in God's mission through sacrificial generosity and intercessory prayer that advances the gospel and unites the Church.

Discussion Questions

Icebreaker: What's the most generous act someone has ever done for you? How did it affect your view of generosity?

- 1. Read Romans 15:22–24. What does Paul's approach to ministry teach us about who truly owns the mission?
- 2. Why is it hard for believers to trust God with their resources? What fears or misconceptions often get in the way?
- 3. According to Romans 15:25–29, how is giving more than a financial act? What makes generosity "gospel work"?
- 4. Review the seven principles of giving from Ben Witherington (sermon notes). Which one stands out to you, and why?
- 5. Read Galatians 6:10 and 1 Timothy 6:17–19. How do these verses shape your understanding of Christian responsibility to others?
- 6. How can generosity heal divisions in the Church, as Paul suggested between Gentile and Jewish believers?
- 7. Read Romans 15:30–33. What does Paul's view of prayer teach us about partnership in ministry?
- 8. How can we as a LifeGroup better support missionaries, ministries, or people in need through prayer and giving?
- 9. What would it look like for generosity to become "joy instead of obligation" in your life?
- 10. How might your faith grow if you began to give or pray more intentionally for others this month?

Prayer Prompt: Spend time praying for those who carry the gospel to difficult places. Ask God to make your group a community known for generosity, prayer, and unity in the gospel.
