Read John 9:1-41

Did anything stand out either from Jerry's message or reading through John together?

What do the disciples assume about the man's blindness in verse 2? What does Jesus say in response? (v.3)

How do the Pharisees respond to the healing? What seems to bother them most? (v.13–16)

Jerry mentioned that, similar to the blind man in our passage, God moves *towards* our helplessness and not *away* from it. When you think of your relationship with Jesus, do you functionally believe that? Why or why not?

Our hearts determine what we see. What does this mean? How have you seen that to be true in your own life and interactions with others?

Jerry outlined Jesus's work in our passage as compassionate, merciful, patient, and redemptive. Which of those 4 ways have you seen Jesus pursuing you as of late?

What do verses 39-41 teach us about spiritual blindness vs. sight? Who is truly "blind" in this story, and why?

What are some things that you may be "spiritually blind" to that God may want to give you sight towards? (Examples would include not investing in the lives of our neighbors, seeing your sin as not that bad, ignoring a certain area of your life or relationship with Christ, etc.)

Read Psalm 139:23-24 together. **End your time praying those verses for the group.**
