Read John 10:1-21

Did anything stand out either from Alex's message or reading through John together?

Jesus says the sheep recognize His voice. What do you think it means for you to recognize Jesus's voice? What are some of the obstacles that you may need to remove in order to "hear" Jesus' voice? (By Jesus's voice, we mean to understand where He is leading you, though it could be audible, it will mostly come to you by direction/discernment).

In our passage, there was a division between people who thought Jesus was demon-possessed and people who thought He was from God. **What is the** difference in heart posture between the two groups? What led each group to make that conclusion about Jesus?

Alex said that the Gospel will either capture our hearts or leave us calloused. **If you were to be honest, would you define your heart as captured or calloused as of late?** What makes you say that answer?

How does the care of Jesus differ from that of the "hired hand" in our passage?

We need to accept being sheep; sheep are easily deceived, necessarily dependent, and deeply loved. What is your initial reaction and thoughts to being a sheep?

Beware: there are thieves and robbers. What are some of the thieves and robbers that we have? Why is it important to be aware of the realities of these thieves and robbers?
