Read John 11:38-57

Did anything stand out either from Justin's message or reading through John together?

The main theme of Sunday's sermon was that what Jesus did for Lazarus, He has already done for you. **What did Justin mean by that?**

Jesus is never indifferent towards us or sin. **So what causes us to be indifferent towards Jesus?**

Do you think of your salvation as a living, breathing miracle? Why or why not? What is the miracle associated with your salvation?

Justin mentioned that John later tells us why the Lazarus story is in his Gospel. **What reason does John give?** (Leader note: If the group is unsure, have them turn to John 20:30-31).

Christ resurrects. What is something in your life that was seemingly "dead" that Jesus resurrected?

Have you ever noticed that Jesus was not the one who took the burial cloths off of Lazarus? What are the implications of Jesus inviting others to do that?

Why do you think the religious leaders felt threatened by Jesus' miracle? What does this say about the danger of hardened hearts?

We can have 2 responses to Jesus: to believe and surrender to Him, or to deny and crucify Him. But you cannot be indifferent. What things are you surrendering to Jesus in this season of your life? Is there anything you are purposefully not surrender to Jesus?
