Read John 16:4-15

Did anything stand out either from Justin's message or reading through John together?

What was/is your understanding of the Holy Spirit from your upbringing? (Ex: We should talk about the HS every time we gather, or it is confusing and therefore I do not think much or focus much on Him, etc.)

According to verse 7, it is to our advantage that we have the Holy Spirit as opposed to the physical Christ with us today. Do you believe that it is to our advantage to have the Spirit? Why is having the Spirit indwell us as opposed to the physical Christ with us a good thing?

One of the purposes of the Holy Spirit in our lives is to convict us. **What is the definition of convict? How does it differ from guilt/shame?** (Raby defined conviction as: To expose sin and its wrongness to convince us of our need for a Savior).

How have you seen the Holy Spirit communicate to you, if at all, in your time of following Jesus? (Ex: in the Bible, in reflection, through worship, prayer, etc.). Specific examples encouraged!

In the end, Satan will be judged for sin, the righteous (followers of God). Why should that bring us comfort? How should that impact how we view our own day of judgement?

How can you know the difference of the Holy Spirit trying to communicate something to you or a different voice? (Ex: The HS will not point you to something that the Bible isn't pointing you towards).

Would you say that you have the Holy Spirit? How do you know?

What is one way you can yield to the Spirit this week?

Are you on mission with the Spirit? What is an area God has placed you in that you can be on mission with?
