Read Exodus 20:7 and Exodus 3:1-12

What stood out or challenged you from Justin's sermon or these verses?

What are some misconceptions of this third commandment that you had growing up or at any point in your Christian journey?

Justin mentioned that the call of the third commandment is not to approach God lightly or flippantly. In what ways do we approach God lightly or flippantly? What is the right approach?

Are there ways that you use God as a means to an end, as opposed to worshiping Him simply because He is worthy? What are some of those ways?

Recount the ways God is worthy of your worship, both universally and in how He has uniquely saved, cared for, and revealed Himself to you in your personal relationship with Him.

Are there ways you can compartmentalize God? (Areas where you do not allow or care for God to impact or be at the center of). How can you re-center Christ into those things or relationships?

Between praying to God, protecting time with God, sitting in the presence of God, and allowing access to God; which could you focus on this week to better connect and heighten your view of just how God and holy God is?
