



REFUEL NEED-TO-KNOWS

Host homes

- Each group will have its own home to stay in. They are gender and grade-specific (ex., 6th-grade boys will be in their own home).
- The parents who are hosting will be background checked and briefed on all Fellowship Students' safety policies. This also applies to all group leaders who are staying in host homes.
- Students will not be allowed to have their cellphones unless it is an emergency.
- If needed, contact with students throughout the weekend can be made directly through small group leaders. All parents will receive the contact information for their students' small group leaders and their host parents.
- Any medication for students will be collected by small group leaders. They will turn that in at check-in on Friday night. If you need to contact your students' leader regarding their medication, you will be given their contact information at Refuel check-in.

- If any parents prefer for their student to stay in their own home rather than their host home for the weekend, they will need to fill out a time away card for Friday and Saturday night.

Food

- All meals for the entirety of the weekend will be provided. If there are any allergies or food restrictions, you can indicate that upon registration, and we will accommodate.
- All meals will be provided at Fellowship, aside from breakfast on Saturday morning. Breakfast food for Saturday will be provided by fellowship staff but served inside each home.

Transportation

- Students will be transported to and from host homes via 15-passenger vans.
- Each group will have its own van and a designated, certified leader to drive their van.
- Transportation Rules:
 - Seatbelts will be worn at all times when riding in the van
 - Speeding will NOT be tolerated. Leaders will be required to drive the speed limit at all times.
 - Only the designated leader will be allowed to drive the vans.
 - Drivers will be required to inform Fellowship Students staff when they arrive safely at their host home.

Host Home Rules/Safety Policies

- NO horseplay.
- Light out means lights out!
- Bullying will absolutely NOT be tolerated at any point during Refuel Weekend.
- Be polite to host homes & host parents.
- Clean up after yourself.
- Leaders and students will absolutely NOT share a bed space.
- Students must stay inside the host homes at all times unless there is an emergency.
- No electronic devices (leaders will already have their phones).
