LESSON 16

THE WORK OF CHRIST (GOD'S NATURE)

In the last lesson we saw that God exists as three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. In this lesson and the next we will examine the nature and works that are unique to Jesus Christ. In the incarnation, when Christ became a man, Jesus took on a human nature while retaining all the attributes of God we studied in lessons 13 and 14. In this lesson we will examine the importance of the humanity of Jesus.
