✦ Hebrews 2:1-4

¹We must pay more careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away. ²For if the message spoken by angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment, ³how shall we escape if we ignore such a great salvation? This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him. ⁴God also testified to it by signs, wonders and various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.

 - a. According to verses 2 and 3, what dangers do believers face if they ignore God's message of salvation?
 - b. What point is the author making in contrasting the "message spoken by angels" with "a great salvation" announced by the Lord?
 3. According to verses 3-4, why is it foolish for us to "ignore such a great salvation"? What can we know about the message of salvation from these verses?
 - a. What roles did the eyewitnesses and the display of the Holy Spirit's ministry play in confirming the message of salvation?
 - b. Why do you think God desires to confirm and make His message trustworthy?
