

# Souled Out Summer

## (Information Pamphlet)

**Dates:** Sunday, May 31st - Friday, June 5<sup>th</sup>

**Where:** Laguna Beach, Florida

**Cost:** \$400

Souled Out is a Christian conference for middle and high school students. It is held at Laguna Beach Christian Retreat on the west end of Panama City Beach, Florida and it focuses on students' relationship with Christ. Morning and evening worship and speakers set the tone for each day. The conference is discipleship oriented, and each student will participate in a D-Group (disciple group) made up of students of their grade and gender. Each D-group is led by college-age Discipleship Leaders (D-Leaders) whose focus is on helping students open up and grow closer to Christ. Lots of free time is scheduled into each afternoon for individual activities, swimming at the pools or beach, playing in the basketball/Ultimate Frisbee/volleyball, and other tournaments, competing in the strong man/woman contest, or just hanging out and relaxing. Souled Out is the perfect setting for students to open up and be real before God and with each other.

Worship will be led by Jonathan and Lisa and their band, MOORE.

## Speakers:

### **The morning speaker is Lee McBride**

Lee is a comedian who uses real-life stories to truly connect with students on a much deeper level. He brings the word straightforwardly and funny and always cuts to the core of what's going on in students' hearts. He was a youth pastor for 13 years, a pastor for 3 years, and for over 15 years has been a full-time missionary to the outdoorsmen of America. He currently is the founder of Hidden Hook Ministries. He has been on over 50 mission trips, spoken at 500 wild game suppers, and preached at over 100 youth camps and retreats. Every August Lee speaks to over 100 football teams in 30 days. Big Lee does multiple events for us here at Troy First Baptist including Football Chapels, Overtime Recharge (5<sup>th</sup> Quarter), Wednesday Night Pop-Ups, and has spoken at our Wild Game Suppers.



### **The Nighttime speaker is Scott Smith:**

Scott Newton Smith has been traveling in itinerant preaching ministry for nearly 30 years. Scott speaks to thousands every year on topics relevant to leaping forward in the effectiveness as followers of Christ as well as clear presentations of the message of Christ and the Gospel. Scott has preached to hundreds of thousands over the last decade alone throughout the eastern United States and in countries overseas.



## Worship Leaders:

### **Morning Worship is led by Mike Marshall**

Mike Marshall is a singer/songwriter based out of Columbus, GA who has a passion for humanity to experience the love and healing of God through music.

Mike first came on the scene at Souled Out in 2021 where his debut song 'JESUS' became a big hit which boasts of indelible confidence found in the finished work of Jesus on The Cross. The goal behind Mike's music is to always point his listeners to a very real person, Jesus. Mike is a genuine leader who truly cares for the hearts and souls of youth. Mike will also be joined by the CityScape Worship leader Mallory Lang.



### **Evening Worship is led by MOORE**

Johnathan and Lisa Moore are the hearts behind Souled Out. Jonathan and Lisa led worship on the road full-time for 15 years, produced over a dozen custom worship projects, and have hosted Souled Out Student Conferences in Panama City Beach for 22 years! For the last 10 years, they served on staff at St Luke Church in Columbus, Georgia as Student Pastors, and Worship Leaders. As of February of 2022, they planted a church called Cityscape Church in Columbus, Georgia. Jonathan and Lisa have led numerous revivals and youth events throughout Obion County.

### **DATES**

Sunday, May 31<sup>st</sup> through Friday, June 5<sup>th</sup>

### **LOCATION**

Laguna Beach Christian Retreat Center, 20016 Front Beach Road- Panama City Beach, Florida

### **FEES**

The total cost of the trip is \$400 with a \$100 Deposit required by Sunday, February 22nd. The deposit secures your spot, and is included in the total price.

### **DEADLINE**

The \$100 Deposit and Registration form are due by Sunday, February 22nd.

**After this date, there is no guarantee that a spot will be available.**

### **FUNDRAISERS**

We will do 2 fundraisers to help with the cost. Our Braided Bread fundraiser will start the first week of March with a pickup date to follow. Our second fundraiser will be our annual Mother's Day Boston Butt and Ham cook.

### **REMAINING BALANCE**

After your first deposit is made there will be two more payments that need to be met. The first payment will be due after the Braided Bread fundraiser. The second will need to be met during our parent meeting. You will receive a total balance after each fundraiser. You can pay the remainder of your balance online or in person at any time before the deadline date.

### **Parent Meeting**

A Required Parent and Student meeting will be held once. This is required for all students attending Souled Out and for a parent of each student even if a student has been to Souled Out before.

**Departure:**

We will leave Sunday, June 4<sup>th</sup> after our worship service. All bags and luggage must be dropped off before service time. We will stop and eat lunch inside the Tupelo Mall Food Court. We will stay the night at First Baptist Church of Andalusia, Alabama. This is 2 hours away from the retreat center.

**RETURN:**

On Friday, June 5th we will leave from camp around 4:00AM and be back for pickup at the church parking lot around late afternoon. We will stay in contact throughout the trip back.

**Safety:**

Church and Souled Out Personnel supervise activities. Medical facilities are nearby. Safe Sanctuaries will be observed including the buddy system. Ocean swimming will follow the beach lifeguard instructions and the Panama City Beach Flag System.

**Communication:**

If an Emergency message needs to be relayed to your child, we ask that you call Tony, or Todd before relaying the message to your student. If your student does not have a phone, you can call us directly. Students are allowed and encouraged to bring their cell phones, but they will have LIMITED access to them throughout the day due to discipleship groups, on the beach, during worship, etc. The goal is to create time and to disconnect from daily stressors. The better we can facilitate a retreat environment of relief, rest, passion, and healing, the more meaningful this trip becomes and the experience for your student and our group as the body of Christ.

**SOULED-OUT MERCH TABLE / SNACK SHOP:**

There is a Souled Out merch table that has anything from T-shirts, Hats, books, digital media, and more. This year's theme shirt is provided. Although we encourage students to take advantage of the mealtimes that are already paid for as apart of your trip. The snack shop is open throughout the day and sells anything like nachos, hot dogs, fries, and any form of concession stand-type food. Students should bring extra money to purchase any of these items
