Question:

Jesus told the woman to "go and sin no more." What's something you could do differently this week to follow Jesus better?

DAY 4

Question:

When someone at school does something wrong, how can you respond like Jesus did—with kindness instead of judgment?

Question:

How can remembering our own need for forgiveness help us forgive others?
