Unit 5: How Can I Tell Right from Wrong? | Lesson 3

Activity

This week, we researched what other worldviews believe about right and wrong. As a family, read the summary of each worldview.

Naturalism

If you use the naturalist worldview map as your worldview map, you worship matter and believe that humans evolved accidentally. Therefore, you believe humans are the highest authority. Right and wrong are just feelings that change between societies. You believe that communities need to have rules so that everyone can live together without fighting all of the time. The humans who are in charge of the government get to decide what is right and what is wrong.

New Spirituality

If you use the new spiritualist worldview map as your worldview map, you worship yourself because you believe god is a part of you. You also believe that humans are spiritual beings that evolved accidentally. Therefore, you believe that right and wrong are feelings and that each person needs to look deep inside his or her heart to find out what is right. You believe that if you follow your heart you will become a better person and you will earn good karma—this means good things will happen to you. If you do not follow your heart, you will earn bad karma—this means bad things will happen to you.

As a family, discuss what each worldview believes about right and wrong. How might believing these different things affect your choices and behaviors? This week, as you read books, watch movies, and listen to songs, pay attention to any messages about right and wrong that may come from one of these worldviews.

As a family, thank God for sending Jesus to save you. Pray specifically for naturalists and new spiritualists. Ask that God would soften their hearts to the Truth and give you opportunities to share the Truth with them.
