1. Election of officers

2. Vote to move \$100,000 of the surplus funds to the capital fund to assist with the roof repair. (*NOTE* In past years, our trustees would handle this directly, but the letter of our bylaws requires a congregational vote. We plan to amend the bylaws/procedures so votes like this will not be required in the future).

3. Special vote – Confirmation of the designation of a significant gift for the building and leadership development.

In order to be prepared for the special vote, please read below to understand what has happened over the past month! God is good!

There has been an act of incredible generosity toward our church. We have received a very substantial gift that, we believe, will significantly enhance our ministries and provide for our building project at the current time.

The vote will confirm the designation of a large gift to go towards:

- 1. The building.** We are in the middle of a big project and this money is providentially timed!
- 2. A ministry leadership development fund.** This will employ developing leaders in non-permanent positions at Hope Fellowship, such as internships. Because these roles will exist outside the annual budget, the elders will oversee the creation and management of these positions.

Why is a Vote is Required? A special gift was given outside of the general fund. Our church governance requires that special initiatives like this be subject to congregational approval, as the congregation authorizes expenditures via the budgeting process or special votes like this. Designating the gift toward the building alone would not require a vote under our bylaws, but allocating funds toward leadership internships introduces a new category that does.

Why Designate the Gift this way? We recommend it be designated as such for multiple reasons. First, due to the conversations of leadership with the donor. Second, because this is in line with our church's mission and vision, as funds will help raise up disciple-makers and kingdom-workers. Third, as we anticipate growth and perhaps a tighter budget in the immediate years following the church expansion, designated personnel money will be of great strategic benefit. A 50/50 split is intended, but leadership wishes to retain flexibility in the event of unforeseen circumstances. For that reason, the vote will not lock in exact percentages.
