## Questions

- The sermon mentions that God always fulfills His plans. How have you seen this truth play out in your own life?
- How does the hide-and-seek analogy from the sermon help you understand God's desire to be found by us?
- What 'clues' has God left in your life that have helped you find Him?
- Pastor Nate mentioned that one way God reveals Himself is through the church. How can we better reflect God to those around us?
- What obstacles might prevent people today from recognizing God's revelation of Himself?

# Life Application

This week, be intentional about looking for ways God is revealing Himself in your daily life. Keep a small journal or note on your phone where you record at least one 'clue' each day that points to God's presence or activity. These might be through nature, conversations, circumstances, or even your own thoughts. At the end of the week, review these moments and thank God for making Himself known to you. Additionally, identify one person in your life who might be missing God's revelation, and pray specifically for their eyes to be opened, then look for an opportunity to share how you've seen God at work.
