## **Questions**

- Why do you think God chose to lead the Israelites through the wilderness instead of the shorter coastal route to the Promised Land?
- How did God's presence manifest itself to guide the Israelites, and what does this teach us about God's faithfulness?
- What was God's strategy in telling the Israelites to backtrack and position themselves between Egypt and the sea?

- How did the Israelites react when they saw Pharaoh's army approaching, and how can we relate to their response?
- What does Moses' leadership response teach us about how to lead Christians through fearful situations?
- How does the parting of the Red Sea demonstrate both God's power and His plans?
- In what ways does this account foreshadow Jesus Christ's ultimate victory over evil in the end times?
- How can we apply the principle of 'moving forward in faith' even when it feels like we might be losing as we follow Jesus Christ?

# **Life Application**

This week, identify one area where Jesus Christ has taught you in His Word to 'move forward' despite fear or uncertainty. Instead of retreating to what feels safe, choose to trust God's plan and take a step of faith in obedience. This might involve sharing your faith with someone, serving in Grace Church, or making a difficult but righteous decision. Remember that God often uses what appears to be weakness or loss to display His glory and power.
