

I was in 'Logos', a Christian bookstore in Calgary when I saw this white t-shirt with the design that is on the front of this newsletter. By this time, all of my old high school friends had found out I was a Christian and none of them were impressed.

Early in my conversion I vividly remember meeting one of those school buddies at a restaurant for lunch. He asked me what was new and I told him that I had become a Christian. Without exaggeration, he didn't say a word, stood up, and left. I've never seen him again.


That was a defining moment for me. A recognition that the 'flow of life' that I had shared with my friends had changed direction. It surprised me.

I hadn't read very much of the bible by that time, and I didn't realize that my call to follow Jesus wasn't just a 'personal experience', but it was a 'public confession'. I was now representing the faith I had embraced; I was representing Jesus.

Saint Paul told the Corinthians that they were 'living epistles' ... that they were the representation of the 'Spirit of the living God'.

When my buddy left the restaurant he wasn't leaving 'me', he was leaving what I now represented. If it was 'just me' he would have stayed and we would have continued our lunch and friendship.

Whether I liked it or not, my friend disowned me because of my 'confession'. I was a Jesus lover and for some reason, who knows, he didn't like that.



Because of my position in ministry I have to pay close attention to cultural shifts, and it is my belief that it will not be long before all Jesus lovers will be 'disowned'; or what they now call 'cancelled'. I can promise you that no matter how kind we are, or how much we outwardly speak and act in love, the 'cultural influencers' will relentlessly reject us as believers.

Jesus performed public miracles and healed people, and still those in power rejected Him. Being an epistle of His means that we 'Go Against the Flow' of what this temporal world is all about; like it or not.

It is our emotionally-conflicting privilege to share in His rejection. If you're like me, I've become a lazy self-absorbed believer who enjoys the ease and leisure of this simple life to much. I need to psych myself up for this emerging cultural tsunami.

I loved my 'Go Against the Flow' t-shirt design back then. Ironically, or contradictorily, it made me feel like I belonged. It confirmed that I was moving in the right direction ... towards truth and love. True Truth and real Sacrifical Love; towards Jesus. It helped to keep me focused and emotionally resilient.

And all of these memories and feelings have returned because my gorgeous wife Jann and I started watching 'The Chosen'. If you haven't seen it yet you need to. It is one of the best representations of who Jesus is that I have ever seen. I have cried during every episode. And interestingly (to me) they use this same kind of 'Go Against the Flow' imagery in their introduction.

I do have to say, for clarity, that to me, 'going against the flow' isn't about being hostile, holier-than-thou, arrogant, or anything like that. It is about remaining filled with love and hope and kindness for everyone. And about dedicatedly and unreservedly following the 'Ichthys' ... the Risen (and soon to return) Christ.
