Sermon Reflection

Words for Meditation: “They saw a star, and they were not content to admire it; they followed it.” – St. John Chrysostom (347-407 CE), Homily VI on the Gospel of Matthew

- What are some “stars” in your own life—questions, longings, disruptions, or moments of beauty—that have asked for your attention? How do you usually respond when something unsettles or invites you?
- In what ways does truly seeing another person—especially someone vulnerable or overlooked—change what becomes possible between you and them?
- What might it look like for you—or for the church—to live “by another way” after seeing Christ at the table and in the world?
