You can so clearly understand that without the renewing of our minds, in a daily sense we all lose a bit of our mind and closeness with our Lord. Yet, I am also reminded of Gods promise "for I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things, present, or things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creatures, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus, our Lord!" Romans I:38-39 Tim's life, even now, is such a walking testimony of this. Each day he walks around with two bibles (one in each hand) wanting them all times of the day. (One belonged to his dad and the other was given to him from Meadow Lakes Baptist church - his last mission work in Alaska, with many signed names which he reads often with tears.) He is ready each day to go to church, to which I have to explain, "we don't have church services today." thankfully many of you "live stream" and record your services, I can put one on for him and he seems to understand, by the grace of the Lord! He needs help dressing, bathing and is no longer able to go on his long walks (which he so loved). I can't express my thanks enough for all of your continued prayers, love and those that have continued to support us. Oh, may the LORD bless you all beyond measure!

Since my last letter, we had our vacation Bible school in July. We had some new families and kids come, which was a blessing to reach out to new folks. Our job this year was being in charge of the food (which I loved doing) and had some great young people to help me. Tim was also a lot of help carrying things to and from and always had a big smile on his face for the kids as they came through the line.

Tarissa and Tekoa's trip to Panama helping brother Cristobal Yanez in the works there for three months seemed to bring each girl back with a great love for missions and those people. They gave a great presentation of all they did.

Praise the Lord for their experience and His watch care over them while they were gone.

Our home is off the market for the time being for a number of reasons. Tim has declined quite a bit and moving him at this point, might be pretty detrimental. We have a granddaughter, Ellie, (who is a CNA) that has come to live with us for a time. She is a great help with her grandfather. She has been such a blessing in so many ways. She loves music, can play the piano and loves to sing. She plays hymns for her grandfather for hours. Tim's great love for music, still bringing him much joy. Also, we had to completely redo our water system which included removing a 20,000 gallon catchment tank and replacing it with a new one. Our old one was rusted out and we were losing water which became very expressive to buy. So we are in debt now over that. The cost was around 5,000.00 dollars. We are praising the Lord for all the men in the church that helped to replace it and did all the work or it would have been twice that amount. Plus, I am looking into trying to get social security early by claiming off Tim's hoping that this might help us for the time being because I can't really leave Tim and go to work at this point. I have spent most of life beside my Husband in the Lords work and helped him which has not given me enough quarters to get my own social security. I covet your prayers over this.

Tim asked me to be sure and thank you all for every thing you have done and please continue to pray for him that he can some how continue to be a witness for the Lord. I know this! In the Spanish services we are holding, he tries to read the words and sing the songs even though I am pretty sure he doesn't understand but if you saw him you might think he did. Our Lord is so good because he just enjoys going!
