Dear Churches and Friends,

October 4th, 2025

It has been a blessed summer. The fall has shown up now and the nights are getting cooler.

We are pleased to report we've been able get our chairs ordered and are excited about their arrival. We took some of the extra funds and painted the auditorium. And would love now to get the carpet replaced. We have a small amount left to do this. We need about \$4000.00 more to be able to complete this renovation. This is the first time since 2010 that we needed to give this attention. God blessed us with the chairs, and we are very grateful for the ones God sent to make this happen,

Gina has had her medication changed again She tells us she thinks it getting better. Please continue to pray for Gina, Eric and Caleb, Erics Mother lives with them also Her health is frail. I know they will appreciate being lifted up.

As for me. I had my knee replaced on September 23rd, I am doing quite well. I'm walking well.

When the surgery was over Bro. Joe came into my room and told me "We got everything we prayed for. The Infection is gone; you now have a regular knee replacement that will be permanent. I will be on oral antibiotics for 6 months as a precaution. I can already feel a great difference and am excited to see it healed. I realized after pondering this that, the 1st surgery was 3 years ago. Then soon after, the glue to the joints turned loose. I walked about 2 ½ years on a knee that was totally loose. Thank you for all your prayers. We are "Praising God." I honestly can say I'm feeling much better.

We now are very excited how God is working here in Fort Hall, ID.

Most know that we took a young girl under our wing, and I homeschooled her and Mya for 3 years. Her grandmother insisted she walk across the stage at the Sho-Ban High School and made her enroll back into the public system. Ammelia stayed in church and started helping Mya with her crew of children, she grew more in the Lord quickly. She had some trials and a lot of discouragement but with the surrender that was made last February, Ammelia was one of the young adults who gave her life to serve God fulltime. She came to us several months ago asking to go to a Bible college. Her focus is "missions" She hopes to take clerical as her major. Currently, she is our bus captain, one of our pianists. And anything that needs done she steps up. We looked around, and she applied for Heartland Bible Baptist College in Oklahoma City. She received her acceptance letter and is totally elated. She also knows a Missionaries daughter that is attending this college which made us feel a little more comfortable.

We asked her to start working on some grants. Her tuition is \$9000.00. We've been bathing this in prayer. Ammelia started doing all she could to see if there was any help, she now has \$4500.00 in grants raised in one week. That is the power of fervent prayer. Please help us pray for Gods guidance in this young girl's future. She is currently employed and is a very good worker. There is little to offer her here on the Reservation.

I'm enclosing a copy of her salvation and surrender experience.

We start "Revival" Sunday morning through Wednesday night.

Seems we need prayer more than anything as so much is changing here at Faith Baptist Church. Thank you again for lifting us up. We are honored.
