Which is exciting all on its own.

I have been printing some chick tracts and have been working on translating a few others with the help of Brenda Bell. It's a lot of trial and error, mostly on my end. The great thing is that people read them and even hold on to them here. We had a watch repairman ask that we give him some tracts to pass out as well. We met him one day while passing out tracts at the Praça da Republica. They have booths set up there every Sunday. I have been able to keep him supplied since October. My plan is to build up a good stock of them. But I am definitely glad to see them being used so quickly.

This next year will commence with us starting our visa process. Our current visas expire in May. We will try to get a visa for 10 years instead of 2 this time. Once I get a date cleared on the visa, I will start making plans to head stateside for furlough. Samuel is graduating high school in April. Please continue to pray for him as he makes plans for his future. The lease on our apartment also ends in April; so we will need to find another place. It will be a busy spring for us. Thank you all so much for faithfully praying with us on these matters. Also, thank you for your faithful financial support and offerings. Our words could not adequately express our gratitude towards you and the Lord for making it possible for us to be here, doing what God has called us to do.
