We thank the Lord that in the last five weeks the Lord has allowed me to baptize 14 new believers who have been added to our missions.

We have made great progress in the school project. About 90% of the necessary furniture is in the classrooms and we expect to be using the new installations by the end of August.

Beloved brethren, we are now only three weeks away from starting the activities celebrating the Month of the Bible in Panama, decreed by a law of the Republic. This gives us a lot of liberty to share the Word of God with the whole country. We are working to have the necessary literature, to have our vehicles in good shape for the trips, and the various groups of brethren organized for each area of the country. I want to thank all our co-laborers for their offerings for this project with which we will be able to bless multitudes with the message of the Gospel of grace. We will be taking Learn with Jesus books to schools, donating Bibles, distributing evangelistic and teaching materials, and preaching in the different provinces of the country. We will be using every lawful means to spread the message. We are praying to God for a great spiritual sowing.

We are grateful to the Lord to now be printing materials with the new printing equipment that we recently acquired. We have a whole new renovated printshop, with high yield copiers, binders and cutters, and the paper and ink that we need to print.

We invest the resources in tools, materials, Bibles, New Testaments, and the other things necessary to achieve the goal of getting the biblical message of salvation to many people. Thank you for helping us to make known the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ to more and more people in Panama by making it possible for us to have discipleship materials for new believers, and Bibles for the most needy (indigenous people, new believers, school teachers, and those who genuinely cannot get one on their own). My ardent desire is that all might have the opportunity to know God and His Word and I pray that God will guide people to the feet of my Lord.

Our missions keep growing with God's help.

In Penonomé, brothers Aureliano and Moisés are leading the congregation and recently four were added to the membership there. These young men are working hard to evangelize the area.

In the mission in El Perú, after many struggles a family of seven people were won to the Lord, five of whom were baptized and added to the church. This has filled us with joy and has strengthened the congregation there.

Meanwhile, in the mission in El Bale, two members were added to the church a few weeks ago.

The brethren of the New Life Baptist Mission at the El Edén Camp are keeping on, working in personal evangelism and growing in the midst of the spiritual battles. Their faith is growing. At the Camp, we continue with the second semester of training of workers.

I thank all those who have been supporting my wife's health with your prayers. She has improved, though she sometimes has bad days. Right now, she is in the process of detoxifying from the medications she took and is following a strict diet. We are happy in the will of God, and we trust that we are in His hands. By the grace of God, she has returned to her normal activities and is applying herself everyday to her ministry to the students and ladies in the different congregations.

Our daughter Ester, a registered nurse, has begun a ministry of helping with health issues. She has acquired the essential medical equipment and medications for helping some of the brethren and is a big help on the trips, especially in the remote areas.

Thanks, a thousand thanks my beloved, for being a part of this work which the Lord is allowing to be done in our small isthmus.
