First Sunday of Epiphany/ Baptism of Jesus



FIRST READING Genesis 1: 1-5

Introduction – Out of chaos, God's word brings order. Out of the formless void, God brings light. This familiar story was good news for the Israelites, who experienced much chaos in their history. It remains good news for us. God created and continues to create new life. God still speaks a holy Word to us.

At the outset, when God created the universe, the earth was lifeless and shapeless; a deep ocean of chaos, shrouded in darkness; brooded over by the Spirit of God.

Then God called for light, and on God's word, light appeared. God saw that light was a good thing, and separated it from the darkness. God named the light Day, and the darkness Night. Evening passed and morning came; the first day was done.

THE HOLY GOSPEL according to St. Mark.

Alleluia. Let the peace of Christ rule in our hearts,* and let the word of Christ dwell in you richly. Alleluia!

(Col. 3:15, 16)

Introduction - Mark's gospel reports the story of Jesus' baptism with some irony: the one on whom the Spirit descends is himself the one who will baptize others with the Holy Spirit.

⁴John the baptizer showed up in the wilderness, proclaiming God's word to people. He called them to be baptized, to completely turn their lives around and receive God's forgiveness for their ruinous ways.

⁵ Owning up to their toxic ways and wrongdoing, people from Jerusalem and all the rural districts of Judea were flocking out to him for baptism in the Jordan River, promising to reform their ways. ⁶Now John was dressed in rough clothes of camel's hair and animal skins, with a leather belt around his waist. He lived off the land eating locusts and wild honey. ⁷He proclaimed the core message, "The one who comes after me is more powerful than I am; I am not worthy to stoop down and untie his sandals. ⁸I only baptize you with water; but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

⁹ During those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. ¹⁰ The moment he came up from the water, he saw the heavens split open and the Spirit coming down like a diving dove and taking hold of him. ¹¹ It was then that a voice from heaven declared, "You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased."




