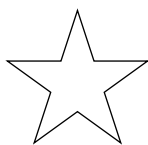

Easy Ways to Improve Writing Utensil Grasp:

- Use small pieces of chalk
- Use small and fat crayons or markers
- Golf pencils (because they are smaller)
- Draw on slant or vertical walls or board (their wrist goes into a slight extension, which is the optimal position when using a pencil)



Classroom News

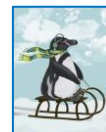
