FUMC scholarships will be available for <u>up to</u> 50% of the cost of the camp. The exact amount given will be based upon the number of kids requesting scholarships and the funds available. If a specific amount is truly needed in order to go, please communicate that to Rev. Greta Hietpas. Additional funds may be available through the conference for those with greater need. The earlier you submit your application, the more likely you will receive funding. You will receive a response to your request in a timely fashion. Remember that Wisconsin UMC Conference camps fill up quickly!

- Register online at <u>www.wiumcamps.org/reg</u>. Pay the full amount and you will be reimbursed the scholarship amount. OR indicate that you will be receiving a church scholarship for half of the cost. The church will be contacted to confirm information and send payment directly to the camping program.
- 2. Complete the application for the FUMC Camp Scholarship and submit it to the church office. <u>Please</u> include proof of registration with the application.
- 3. \*\*\*Note that if for some reason you cancel your camp registration, there is a \$50 cancellation fee which the Conference Camping Program will deduct from your payment. You would receive a refund for the remaining amount. You must fully reimburse the church for the scholarship.
