

United Methodist Conference Church Camps
Procedure for Scholarship Application 2022

The Wisconsin Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church owns two camps, both situated in a beautiful setting on a lake. They are Pine Lake Camp and Camp Lucerne. Each summer our conference provides organized camp programs. Campers sleep in cabins, have meals provided, gather around a campfire, sing, swim and grow deeper into their faith through small group activities, crafts and discussions. It is a chance to meet new friends. Funds from the Children's Ministries budget and anonymous donors provide camper scholarships because FUMC affirms and encourages these opportunities for children and youth. FUMC scholarships will be available for up to 50% of the cost of the camp. **The exact amount given will be based upon the number of kids requesting scholarships and the funds available.** If a specific amount is truly needed in order to go, please communicate that to Rev. Greta Hietpas. Additional funds may be available through the conference for those with greater need. The earlier you submit your application, the more likely you will receive funding. You will receive a response to your request in a timely fashion. Remember that Wisconsin UMC Conference camps fill up quickly!

1. Register online at www.wiumcamps.org/reg. Pay the full amount and you will be reimbursed the scholarship amount. OR indicate that you will be receiving a church scholarship for half of the cost. The church will be contacted to confirm information and send payment directly to the camping program.
2. Complete the application for the FUMC Camp Scholarship and submit it to the church office. **Please include proof of registration with the application.**
3. ***Note that if for some reason you cancel your camp registration, there is a \$50 cancellation fee which the Conference Camping Program will deduct from your payment. You would receive a refund for the remaining amount. **You must fully reimburse the church for the scholarship.**
