Condemned Neither by His Works nor His Words Verses 31-36

Jesus asked the Jews for which of His works they were stoning Him. They stated it was not for His _____, but for His _____ professing to be God, which God’s written Word stated was blasphemy for a man to claim.

Quoting Psalm 82, Jesus turned their accusation back on them with an unanswerable argument:

- The Word of God cannot be broken; no one can escape its truth and justice by claiming _____ in a single word of it.
- God’s Word in Psalm 82 calls God’s human judges “gods” because the Word of God had come to them for establishing His divine _____.
- The Jews had never before claimed that either God (or Asaph) had committed an error by calling these judges ‘gods.’
- Arguing from less to greater, Jesus showed them that their actions were without understanding and belief:

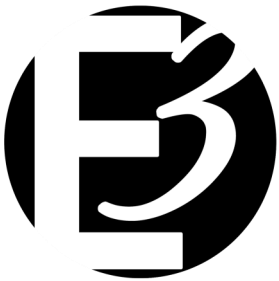
1. The Word of God (in written form) had come to the judges, but Jesus is _____ Himself the Word of God (the Word Incarnate)!
2. The judges, like all other men, were born, but Jesus was _____ from Heaven into the world by the Father.
3. The judges were “sons of God” in a general sense only, but Jesus is God’s “one and only Son.” John 1:14, 18; 3:16
4. The judges received and worked to obey the Law under God’s will, but Jesus perfectly satisfied the Law through every word and work He _____ in God’s plan for Him as Savior.

Be Convinced by His Works and His Words Verses 37-42

Since the Jews were doubtful of Jesus’s _____, He challenged them to recognize the significance of the Father’s _____ signs He was doing.

Unable to debate His wisdom and truth and unwilling to believe and repent, they again reacted with _____; but it was not yet the Father’s time for Jesus to lay down His life.

Ministry Tree

Our annual Ministry Tree event is Sunday, December 7. The tree will be located to the left of the platform. You will be given the opportunity during both services to participate in this mission event. Please select one or more of the following ways to be involved.
