- Following Jesus humbly, practicing repentance, and avoiding gossip or division.

- Prays for and with group members and connects with them as needed.
- Builds relationships that foster discipleship, care, and connection.
- Asks for help and stays connected with campus staff.

- Facilitates honest, Scripture-rooted conversation.
- Prepares well, communicates clearly, and follows through.
- Respects time by starting and ending on schedule.
- Keeps group focused on the mission: Discipleship, Relationship, Care, and Generosity.
