

6. What does "in their mouth was found no guile" mean?

Guile=Deceit, subtilty No deceit, only truth.

Isaiah 48:17,18,22, 57:26-27

17 Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.

9. What practical steps have been revealed to achieve Peace of Mind?



1) Patience - Psalms 27:14

14 Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

1 Patience - Luke 21:19 19 In your patience possess ye your souls.





Trust - Psalms 40:4

4 Blessed is that man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.

2 Trust - Proverbs 3:1,2

- 1 My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:
- 2 For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.

Trust - Proverbs 3:5-7

- 5 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.
- 6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

2 Trust - Proverbs 3:5-8

7 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

Prayer - Philippians 4:6,7

6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

4 Prayer - 1 Thessalonians 5:16-25

- 16 Rejoice evermore.

(4) Prayer - 1 Thessalonians 5:16-25

- 19 Quench not the Spirit.
- 20 Despise not prophesyings.
