# Revelation 14:1-5



## Revelation 14:1

1 And I looked, and, lo, **a Lamb** stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, **having his Father's name written in their foreheads.**

## Revelation 14:2

2 And I heard a voice from heaven,  
as the voice of many waters, and  
as the voice of a great thunder: and  
I heard the voice of harpers harping  
with their harps:



## Revelation 14:3

3 And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which **were redeemed from the earth.**

## Revelation 14:4

4 These are they which were **not defiled with women**; for they are virgins. These are they which **follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth.**



## Revelation 14:4

These **were redeemed from among men**, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.

## Revelation 14:5

5 And in their mouth was found **no guile**: for they are **without fault** before the throne of God.

## 1 Peter 1:20-23

20 For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, **when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God.**

**Guile=Deceit, subilty**  
**No deceit, only truth.**

**Psalms 32:1,2; John 1:47;  
1 Peter 1:21,22, 3:10-12**



# No Guile



## 1 Peter 3:10-12

10 For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile:

## **Isaiah 48:17,18,22**

22 There is **no peace**, saith the

## Isaiah 57:20,21

20 But the wicked are like the troubled sea, when it cannot rest, whose waters cast up mire and dirt.

21 There is no peace, saith my God, to the wicked.

**everlasting strength:**


